The 1999 Stonehedge Napa Valley Zinfandel is lively and intense with ripe jammy black currant, raspberry and chocolate flavors and aromas framed by cracked pepper spice. It is richly textured with generous toasty vanilla oak, rich tannins, and a lingering delicious finish. All grapes were grown in St. Helena except small amounts of merlot from Rutherford. A great companion to grilled Beef, Roast Turkey, spicy dishes or strong cheese.
